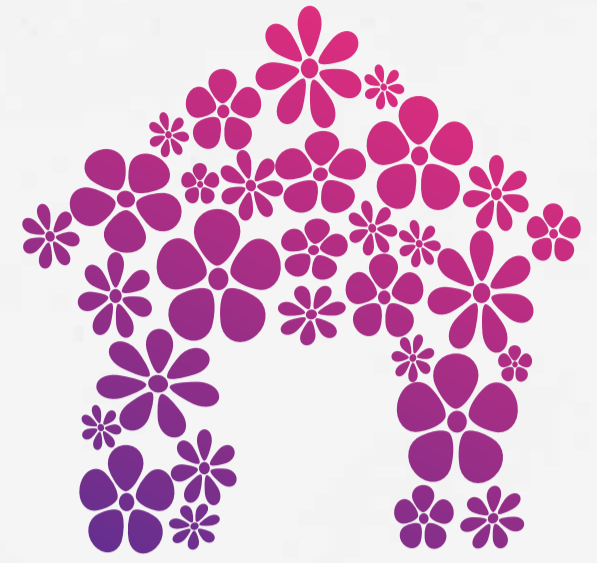

ABOUT HABITAT FOR HUMANITY



Habitat for Humanity International is a global non-profit housing organization founded by Millard and Linda Fuller in 1976, based on the conviction that every man, woman and child should have a decent, safe and affordable place to live.

Habitat for Humanity Indonesia is part of the wider Habitat for Humanity International network, seeking to bring people together to build homes, communities and hope. Headquartered in Jakarta, Habitat began operating in Indonesia in 1997 and currently works in 13 provinces. As of March 2013, Habitat for Humanity Indonesia has served more than 39,500 families. Its largest program was rebuilding after the 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami: in which more than 8,000 families benefited from Habitat's interventions.

ABOUT WOMEN BUILD & BALI PROGRAM



Women Build Indonesia is a program designed to empower women to make a positive impact on society by building simple decent and healthy homes for low income families including women and children in Indonesia. The program aims to help teach women about construction skills and bring together women from completely different backgrounds to address a common issue: poverty housing in Indonesia. The success of this first event in Indonesia proved that the program is well on its way to achieving its goals.

Habitat for Humanity Indonesia - Bali Program is a subsidiary of Surabaya Branch and started its program in 2008 by implementing its first housing program. Since its establishment, Bali Program has served a total of 392 families by March 2013. Habitat for Humanity Indonesia - Bali Program continues to develop and improve the construction of simple, decent and affordable housing. Special attention and sensitivity to the local culture is given in the design of the houses and in achieving the goal of eradicating poverty housing.
